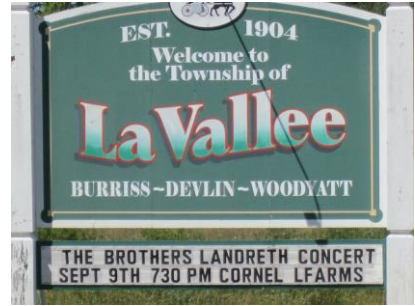


Scenes from The Brothers Landreth Concert, September 9, 2013
