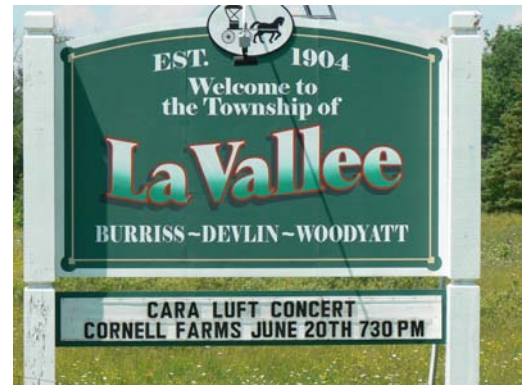


## Scenes from the Cara Luft Concert, June 20, 2010
